

Sibel Akin-Sabuncu is an Associate Professor of Curriculum and Instruction in the Faculty of Education at TED University in Türkiye. She obtained her Ph.D. degree in Curriculum and Instruction program at Middle East Technical University and her post-doc degree at Teachers College, Columbia University.
